What Yeshua said about his Purpose

Matthew 5:17 Do not suppose that I have any intention of doing away with the Torah or the Prophets. My purpose is rather to place them on a firmer footing by interpreting them correctly in terms of God’s ultimate will as He originally intended for His commandments to be obeyed.

The Law of God, also known as the Torah, emanates from the abiding goodness of God’s nature and thus stands forever, God being unchangeable. When we observe the Torah, it is a reflection of His Divine Nature resident within us.

Exodus 6:2 — 9:35

1. God knew of Egypt's advanced knowledge of magic so why did He have Aaron perform a feat that could be easily duplicated?
2. How do we respond today to the reported miracles of other peoples and faiths?
3. Why were the plagues sent?
4. What is the point of teaching the world about God and His power if He simultaneously hardens Pharaoh's heart so that he ignores the information?
5. In the first five plagues, it appears that Pharaoh hardens his own heart and then after that, God does the hardening. What transpired that cause this momentous change?

Peer Review: Fulfilling Scripture

1 Thessalonians 5:21 Test everything! Grasp a hold of that which is determined to be true.

Proverb 18:17 The first to present his case seems right, until another comes forward and examines him.

Peer Review is a process that journals and white papers use to ensure the information that is published represents the best scholarship currently available.

What should happen is that when a journal or white paper is ready to be published, the editors should send it out to other scholars to get their opinion on the quality of the scholarship, its relevance to the field, its appropriateness for publication, an evaluation of its sources, etc. Unfortunately, for the Hebrew Roots world, this seldom happens.

We, at the House of David Fellowship, will attempt to help fill this void. Our first assignment will be due January 1st, 2011. We will publish the results on our Blog for public consumption and debate once we go public.
