What Yeshua said about his Purpose

Matthew 5:17 Do not suppose that I have any intention of doing away with the Torah or the Prophets. My purpose is rather to place them on a firmer footing by interpreting them correctly in terms of God's ultimate will as He originally intended for His commandments to be obeyed.

The Law of God, also known as the Torah, emanates from the abiding goodness of God's nature and thus stands forever, God being unchangeable. When we observe the Torah, it is a reflection of His Divine Nature resident within us.

Today's Torah Portion Deuteronomy 16:18 — 21:9

1. What is the textual criticism issue we need to take note of in Romans 14:1-6?
2. How does the text that shouldn't be there impact our opponent's argument?
3. Deuteronomy 17:18 And it shall be, when he sits upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this Torah in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites.
What exactly, is to be written?
4. Using this portion as a dictionary:
 - * How did they identify a false prophet?
 - * What should they do with false prophets?
 - * What should we do with false prophets?

As you know, an aspect of our outreach is to new people coming into the Hebrew Roots walk. What I would like to do is have each family (we'll call this a peer review process) take a presentation given this year and form around 5 questions. I will collect these and create a "final exam" for the "What About Scriptures" and prepare it for publication at the Feast of Tabernacles, Season of our Joy, in Missouri this year.

I'm thinking the best way would be for me to assign each family a specific presentation. If for some reason a family cannot do theirs, then they can let me know and I will do it or another family can do it. A family could also volunteer for 2 if they so wanted.

Once I have the "final exam" completed, I'll make it available to each family in our congregation so they can make a determination of how ready they are to "give an account" on these basic foundational subjects.

Let me know what you guys think.
