What About Scripture: Colossians 2:14

Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross. (KJV)

[Friberg] χειρόγραφον a handwritten document; in legal matters a promissory note, a record of indebtedness, bond; fig. in Col. 2.14, **not as the law itself**, but as the record of charges (for breaking God's law), which stood against us and which God symbolically removed by "nailing it to the cross", handwritten account, record of debts.
