### Winning a People

 One Law, Two Sticks: A Critical Look at the Hebrew Roots Movement

• Our Purpose in This Paper:

 By issuing this paper, we wish to identify and describe One Law theology and the related Hebrew Roots movement, both historically and today, and to give an informed opinion as to the errors as well as the inherent dangers of it.

- We in the messianic Jewish movement also wish to make clear the fact that we are opposed to One Law theology...
- In our view, therefore, it is wrong to admonish Gentile believers universally to think that they need to observe the Torah.

- We in the messianic Jewish movement also wish to make clear the fact that we are opposed to One Law theology...
- In our view, therefore, it is wrong to admonish Gentile believers universally to think that they need to observe the Torah. It is clear, furthermore, that the Apostles dealt with this precise question of Gentile Torah observance and answered it on point in <u>Acts 15</u>.

- The idea behind "One Law" theology, whether stated or implied, is that he who keeps the law given to Israel, therefore IS Israel.
- Accordingly, "One Law" theology is simply a form of replacement theology.
- By keeping the laws which are specific to Israel, one thereby presumes to be Israel.

 This incorrect desire to "keep Torah" in order to become Israel is a deception that dates back to the time of the Apostles. (I Timothy 1:4, Titus 3:9).

 I Timothy 1:4 Neither give heed to myths and endless genealogies. Such things promote useless speculations rather than God's redemptive plan which is by faith.

 This incorrect desire to "keep Torah" in order to become Israel is a deception that dates back to the time of the Apostles. (I Timothy 1:4, Titus 3:9).

 Titus 3:9 But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and disputes about the law; for they are unprofitable and worthless.

 ...by keeping the law, a person proves that they are Israel. This is the Hebrew Roots premise.

 But furthermore, as opposed to the gospel of scripture which proclaims the good news of forgiveness of sin, the Hebrew Roots message is a gospel of law.

- To wit, that man is to be reconciled unto God not by faith in God, but by keeping the Law of Moses.
- Accordingly, no person can hope to be in a healthy relationship with God unless he or she is keeping the weekly Sabbath, the appointed feasts, and the dietary laws.
- The scriptures testify otherwise. (Col. 2:16).

 In Hebrew Roots, the message is that God is supposedly angry at the Gentile church because the world is eating the wrong foods, and because humans are failing to gather on the correct appointed days.

The Hebrew Roots message to the Gentiles is that the reason Messiah died on the tree was not to deliver the Gentile from sin, but to deliver the Gentile from being a Gentile.
As if being a Gentile would somehow be unacceptable to God.

- The gospel message therefore, for the Hebrew Roots enthusiast, is that God has sent His son into the world in order to conform people to the image of a Jew.
- After all, Yeshua is Jewish, so all people must be like Him...
- People they list: Eddie Chumney, Bill Cloud, Brad Scott, Rico Cortes, HRN, etc..

#### Torah for Gentiles

At First Fruits of Zion, we believe that the Torah is a source of spiritual blessing for Jewish and Gentile believers. We encourage Gentile believers to take hold of the uniquely Jewish aspects of Torah observance such as Sabbath, the festivals, and the biblical dietary laws as part of their walk of discipleship.

 However, we also acknowledge that the apostles did not require the Gentile believers to do so. They wrote to the Gentiles as follows: Acts 15:28-29 (the 4)

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- They kept as much as they could, but were not legally liable for certain Jewish distinctive: the commandments of circumcision, Sabbath, festivals, and Levitical dietary laws.
   Side note: Isn't "Don't eat anything that
  - hasn't had the blood removed" a Levitical dietary law?

 That means that the God-fearing Gentiles could not be punished by the leadership of the Jewish community for failure to keep those particular commandments because they were not legally "under the law" in the same way that Jewish people were.

#### They'll Learn the Rest Later

 The apostles were simply offering the Gentiles four minimum standards for the sake of establishing fellowship within the Jewish community. After accepting those four standards, the Gentiles would learn about the rest of the Torah in the synagogue every Sabbath and start observing more of it. (Acts 15:21)

 David Stern - Jewish NT Commentary, (Jewish NT Publications, Inc., 1999), 279. • "Let the Gentiles enter the Messianic Community without becoming Jews, and don't be troubled over it, because, no matter where these Gentile believers live, they will continue visiting the local synagogue and hearing what Judaism teaches about living a godly life."

...The Gentiles under discussion in Acts 15 were already on the trajectory of Torah.
Their presence in the synagogue on Sabbaths indicates that they were already worshipping on the Sabbath.

 Their participation in the Jewish community indicates that they were already engaged in Torah life on some level and could be expected to continue to mature in it as they learned.

 As for their own halachic authority over the Gentile believers, the apostles refused to lay anything on them beyond the four "essentials" of Acts 15.

Anything beyond those four essentials

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- As for their own halachic authority over the Gentile believers, the apostles refused to lay anything on them beyond the four "essentials" of Acts 15.
- Anything beyond those four essentials they left up to the leadership of the synagogues where the Gentile believers attended.

- If the apostles intended for the Gentiles to eventually learn the Jewish particulars of Torah (such as circumcision, Sabbath, festivals, and Levitical dietary laws) and practice them, they never stated that expectation [here].
- Once again, "Don't eat anything that hasn't had the blood removed" is a Levitical dietary law.

 Nor did they offer a timeframe for a Gentile in a believing synagogue to make the transition from non-observant to fully <u>Torah-ob</u>servant (i.e. Jewish).

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 They were silent regarding any specific plan for Gentile believers to eventually become obligated to the circumcision, the Sabbath, the festivals, and the dietary laws. They neither forbade the Gentiles from practicing the Jewish aspects of Torah; nor did they require them to do so.

- The Proof is in the Prophets
- "With this the words of the prophets agree..."

 In what way does this passage justify a Gentile exemption from circumcision, conversion to Judaism, and full liability to the laws of the Torah?

 According to the Amos passage, the restored Davidic kingdom will include Gentiles who bear God's Name. Paul's Gentile believers fit the prophet's description well. They were Gentiles from the nations who identified themselves with God's Name and sought after God because of the kingship of Yeshua.

- However, if the Gentiles who seek Yahweh through Yeshua must be circumcised to become legally Jewish, they cease to be Gentiles. (I agree for the most part)
- By virtue of the fact that Amos calls them "Gentiles" who bear God's Name, they cannot be Jews, nor can they be proselytes to Judaism.

- The moment that such a Gentile legally converted to Judaism, they would become legally (halachically) Jewish and no longer be a Gentile who bore God's Name.
- In that case, the believing Gentiles would fail to fulfill the prophecy because the prophecy clearly speaks of these God seekers as Gentiles.

- For the prophecy to be literally fulfilled, both Jews and Gentiles must exist in the days of Messiah--an impossibility if all Gentiles were forced to become legally Jewish.
- Amos's Gentiles are to be vassals of the Jewish king. As such, they are to be part of the πολιτειασ [commonwealth] of Israel, with rights as citizens of Israel.

- They are to be <u>bound</u> to the laws of the king of Israel, but they are to be regarded as Gentiles.
- They have a legitimate place in the kingdom and citizenship in Israel, but they still maintain their own non-Jewish, legal identity.

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• Preliminary Conclusion:

- Observing all of Torah does not make one (halachically) Jewish (including circumcision).
- Converting to Judaism would cause them to become legally (halachically) Jewish.

 The child that is born of a Jewish mother and a non-Jewish father is a Jew.

- Both agree that a Jew is fully obligated to the entire Torah and Gentiles are not.
- So if a Jewish woman marries a Gentile man (both in the lord – I Cor. 7:39) and then have children, according to orthodox Judaism, the children are Jewish and fully obligated to the entire Torah.

• Flip that, the children, as Gentiles, are not.

 So, how can, in the situation of a mixed marriage, a Gentile father, who is only *invited*, not legally obligated to a Torah obedient lifestyle, prepare his presumably Jewish children for a lifestyle of *obligatory* obedience to the requirements of the Torah in a credible and sustainable way?

Perhaps Paul comes close to doing so in Colossians 2:16 where he lists the Sabbath, the festivals, the new moons, and the dietary laws as matters for which the Gentile believers of Colossae should not be judged.

 He only says that Gentile believers are not to be judged regarding those matters--a statement he could not have made regarding Jewish believers.

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
