Review

- Golden Rule
- Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.
- Do unto the lost as you would have them do unto you if you were lost.

Review

- Luke 15:1 Then drew near unto him all the **publicans** and **sinners** to hear him.
- 2 The Pharisees and scribes **complained indignantly** saying, “This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.”
- 3 He spake this **parable** unto them, saying...

Review

- Three stories explain why this is the correct attitude when something is lost and the activity that results in both Heaven and on Earth.
- While Yeshua has the Pharisees attention, he goes on to explain the principle that wealth is frequently a snare and tends to promote unrighteousness.

Review

- Matthew 19:21 Yeshua said unto him, “If thou wilt be perfect, go *and* sell what thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come *and* follow me.”
- 22 But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.

Review

- Matthew 19:23 Then said Yeshua unto his disciples, “Verily I say unto you, A **rich man** shall have great difficulty entering into the kingdom of heaven.”
- 24 “And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a **rich man** to enter into the kingdom of God.”

Review

- The management of our allocated resources demonstrates “the working out of our salvation.”
- This management dictates our upcoming non-transitory housing.
- Remember: No one is saved now that is still alive and the definition changes with each succeeding age.

Review

- Story 4
- How **well** are you handling your resources?
- The unjust steward provided for his **transitory housing** (v4).
- Yeshua instructs his disciples **to do something** so that when they die, they will have provided for their non-transitory housing. (v9)

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:1 And he said also unto his disciples, There was **a certain rich man**, which had a **financial manager**; and the same was accused that he had mismanaged the **rich man's** property.
- 2 And he called him, and said unto him, What is this that I hear about thee? Prepare the final accounting prior to the surrender of your stewardship.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:3 Then the steward said within himself, What shall I do? For my lord taketh away from me the stewardship: I cannot do physical labor; to beg I am ashamed.
- 4 I've got it, that is, a plan so that when I am put out of the stewardship, I can put the debtors under obligation to me so that they may receive me into their homes.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:5 So he called **every one** of his lord's debtors *unto him*, and said unto the first, How much owest thou unto my lord?
- 6 And he said, A hundred measures of oil. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty. **50%**

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:7 Then said he to another, How much owest thou? And he said, A hundred measures of wheat. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and write fourscore. **80%**

Luke 16:1-13

- Summary of actions:
- Unjust steward caught mismanaging his lord's finances.
- He realizes he will be fired.
- Steward devises plan while still steward to 'win' the favor of the lord's debtors thereby hopefully providing himself with some assistance after he is fired.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:8 The lord knows the unjust servant ripped him off but still commends him for his shrew actions in attaining 'friends' (the lord's debtors) for the future.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:9 Yeshua says to the disciples, contrasting what the **rich man** said, “Handle the blessing of [money] properly, by caring for those who are less fortunate, thereby gaining ‘friends’ (their favor), whose end result will be future **non-transitory** housing.
- In addition, those friends you made will be there to greet you when you arrive.” [LMM]

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:10a General principle:
- Those that are faithful in a small allocation shall be faithful with a large allocation because they are being led by the indwelling spirit. [LMM]
- Remember: Wealth is commonly a snare and tends to promote unrighteousness.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:10b General principle:
- He that is characterized by a continuous pattern of violating Divine law with their small allocation will continue that pattern even were they to be given a greater allocation for while they may have the indwelling spirit (10 virgins), they are not being led by the spirit. [LMM]

Remember

- Our inheritance “Salvation”:
- Luke 20:34-36
- I Corinthians 9:27 αδοκιμος
- Friberg: *Strictly, failing to meet the test; hence, unqualified; (1) of athletic endeavor disqualified...*

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:11-12 Imagine a wealthy owner who desires to educate his son for managing the estate to which he is the heir.
- **OR**...Imagine the Most High who desires to educate His children for managing the inheritance to which they are an heir.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:11-12 The father allows the son to prove his fitness for the inheritance by allowing him to have control of something that is of little value except as an instrument for forming and discerning character.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:11-12 **OR**...Our Heavenly Father allows His children to prove their fitness for their inheritance by allowing them to have control of something that is of little value (money on earth) except as an instrument for forming and discerning character.

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:11-12 If the son proves unfaithful in this insignificant charge, he is disinherited.
- **OR**...If our Heavenly Father, who has given us all the tools we need to discern His will, observes that we are not being faithful in whatever our allotment is on earth, then we too will not inherit the Kingdom (MK).
I Corinthians 6, Galatians 5, Ephesians 5

Luke 16:1-13

- Luke 16:11 Therefore, if you did not prove to be faithful in handling worldly wealth, who will commit to your trust that which is true? (Luke 19:17 10/5 cities? MK)
- 12 And if you have not been faithful in that which is another's, who shall give you that which is your own (your inheritance)?
- Example: 'Trusts' and a Certain Rich Man...

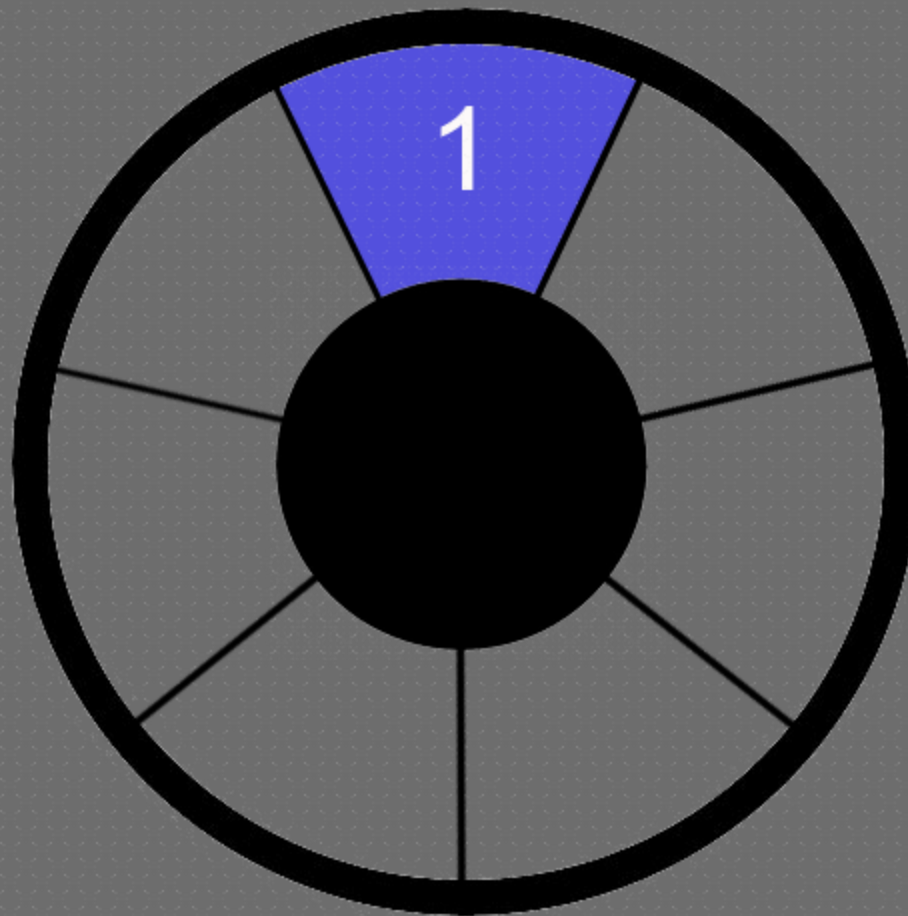
- Luke 16:13 Conclusionary Statement:
- **Note: Money now personified as a deity**
- A servant cannot be at absolute disposal to two masters. You cannot serve the god Yahweh and the god Money.
- Summary: Yeshua is trying to reach out to the Pharisees (who are listening) and help them realize that their tradition is in error..

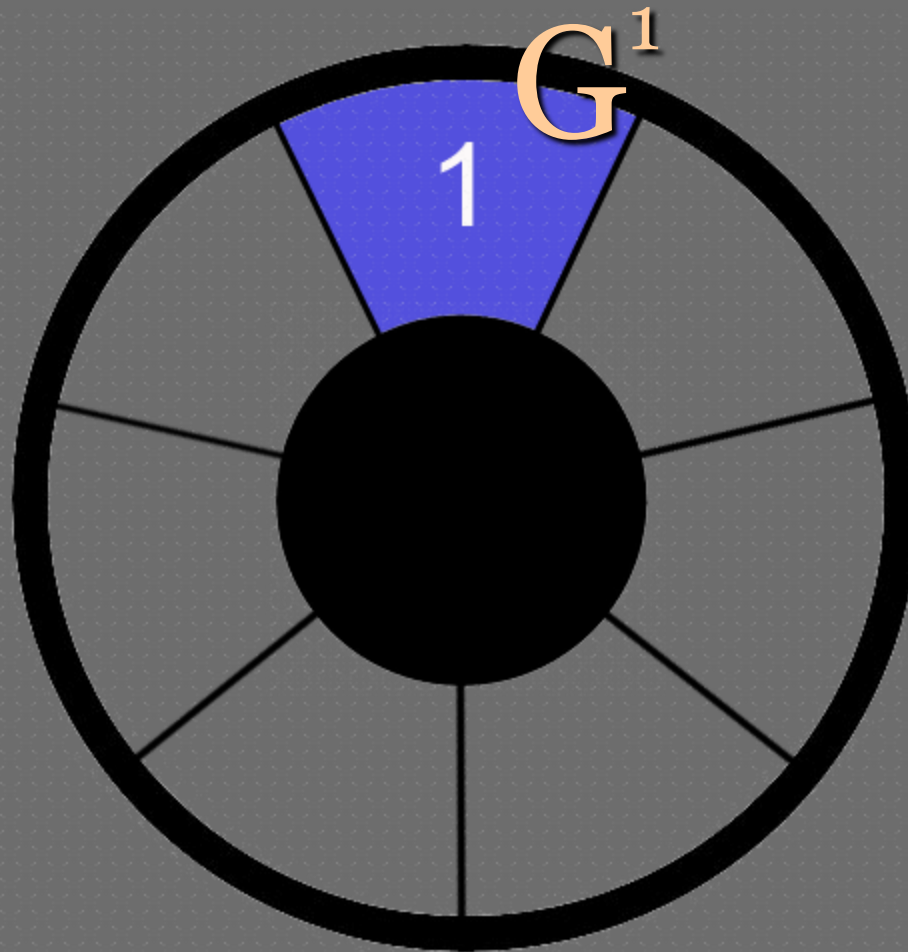
